



Drop "May Valley" (x2) off the base map. The blue community names are great for base map orientation but I don't know if May Valley is an official name of the area. Lots of stuff is named May Valley (park, road) but the area May Valley is in (at least the west portion) is Coalfield. It will show up again on the UAC Subarea map layer.

Bring the font size up on the mountain names (Cougar, Squak, Tiger) to the size of the school font.

Lets drop the parks' shading (pattern) off the base map or make it much more subtle. Maybe using the font color of green in the size like the communities with a light green line at the boundaries would make it less distracting but still leave it for orientation. Maybe you have another idea.

This is 164th Ave SE. Tag it like you did 128th, 156th, etc. It's part of one of the transportation corridors so is a good orientation point.

A solid line for the UAC boundary seems cleaner.

The park, landfill shading may come back on the UAC Subarea layer and/or the UAC District layer.

Is this Elliott Bridge or the name of a development?

Like with the park shading, lets drop the one for the landfill on the base map. It will come back at least on the land use layer.
