



This is 164th Ave SE. It's part of the major traffic corridor. Mark it the same way you did 156th and 128th.

Pull the "May Valley" text out. It will show up on the subarea map. I'm not certain where the name comes from (theme) although it shows up on road, park and precinct names.

Maybe we take the fill for the park/natural areas out completely and rely on the boundary line and the park name text. You already have a green boundary. Maybe we just make the park name text follow a pattern like lakes do. Lake McDonald and Lake Kathleen (e.g.) use a blue italic font (looks bold). Perhaps the park name can be italic and the same font size as for lakes, but green to link it to the park boundary.

I can't tell if this is a different park (i.e. not Squak Mtn Pk).

A solid boundary line for the UAC will probably be cleaner.

I wonder if we shouldn't follow the same idea when marking the landfill. Maybe a colored line with no fill but text like parks and lakes.
